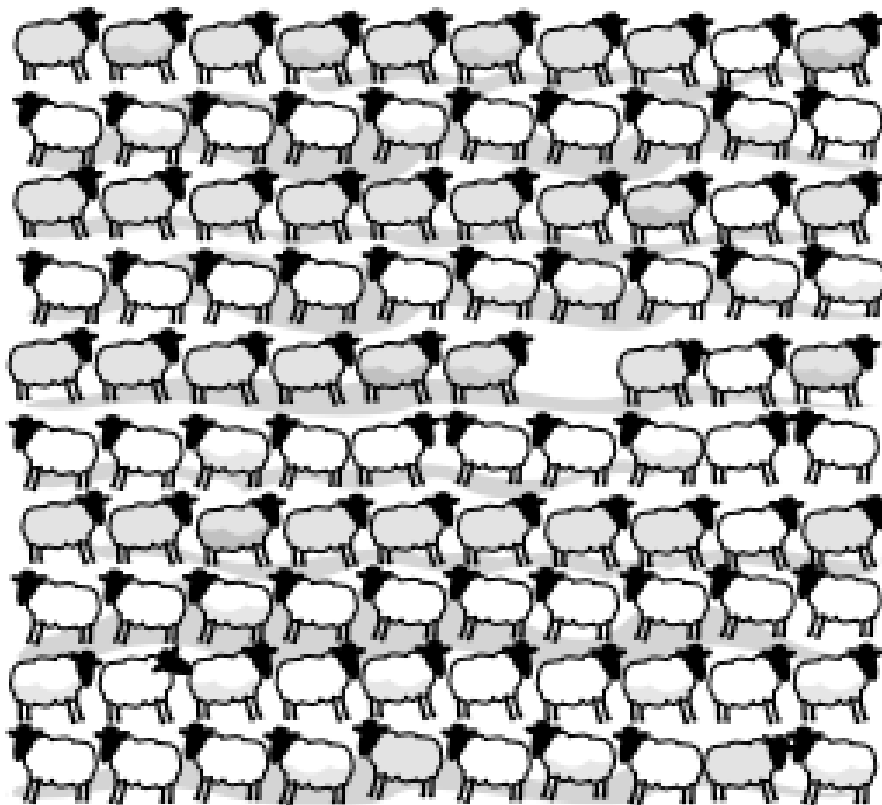

Craft Activity

Woolly sheep

You will need:

- Sheep template on back page
- Cotton wool balls
- Glue

Cut out the sheep on the back page and cover it with the cotton wool.



Craft Activity

Edible sheep

You will need:

- Plain biscuits (e.g. digestives)
- Giant chocolate buttons
- White chocolate buttons
- Chocolate chips
- Icing
- Mini marshmallows

Cover one side of the biscuit with icing.

Stick a giant chocolate button just below the centre of the biscuit for the nose.

Use a dab of icing to stick two white chocolate buttons onto the top half of the giant chocolate button and then some more icing to stick a chocolate chip on top of each white button to make the eyes.

Cover the rest of the icing with marshmallows to make the wool.



Outdoor Activity Suggestions

Round up the sheep

You will need:

- Balloons
- Marker pen
- A racquet, bat or maybe just a long handled wooden spoon

Blow up the balloons and draw a sheep face on each one.

Decide an area that will be the pen.

Using the racquet (or spoon) but no hands move your balloon sheep into their pen.

Who can do it fastest?

Is it easier to work as a team?
