The Resurrection of Jesus

Early on the first day of the week, while it was still dark, Mary Magdalene came to the tomb and saw that the stone had been removed from the tomb. So she ran and went to Simon Peter and the other disciple, the one whom Jesus loved, and said to them, "They have taken the Lord out of the tomb, and we do not know where they have laid him." Then Peter and the other disciple set out and went toward the tomb. The two were running together, but the other disciple outran Peter and reached the tomb first. He bent down to look in and saw the linen wrappings lying there, but he did not go in. Then Simon Peter came, following him, and went into the tomb. He saw the linen wrappings lying there, and the cloth that had been on Jesus' head, not lying with the linen wrappings but rolled up in a place by itself. Then the other disciple, who reached the tomb first, also went in, and he saw and believed; for as yet they did not understand the scripture, that he must rise from the dead. Then the disciples returned to their homes.

Jesus Appears to Mary Magdalene

But Mary stood weeping outside the tomb. As she wept, she bent over to look into the tomb; and she saw two angels in white, sitting where the body of Jesus had been lying, one at the head and the other at the feet. They said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping?" She said to them, "They have taken away my Lord, and I do not know where they have laid him." When she had said this, she turned around and saw Jesus standing there, but she did not know that it was Jesus. Jesus said to her, "Woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you looking for?" Supposing him to be the gardener, she said to him, "Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid him, and I will take him away." Jesus said to her, "Mary!" She turned and said to him in Hebrew, "Rabbouni!" (which means Teacher). Jesus said to her, "Do not hold on to me, because I have not yet ascended to the Father. But go to my brothers and say to them, 'I am ascending to my Father and your Father, to my God and your God." Mary Magdalene went and announced to the disciples, "I have seen the Lord"; and she told them that he had said these things to her.

Stained glass cross

You will need:

- Black paper or card
- Scissors

- Coloured tissue paper
- Glue

Cut a large cross out of the black paper. This reminds us of the sadness of Good Friday when Jesus died on the cross. Carefully cut out the middle of the cross so that you are left with a cross shaped frame. Glue tissue paper over the hole in the cross. When the cross is covered in tissue paper hold it up to the light or stick it on a window to see the light shining through. This reminds us of the joy on Easter Sunday when Jesus rose again.



Craft Activity

Easter egg decorating

You will need:

- Hard boiled eggs
- Pens, paints

- Ribbons, sequins etc
- Glue

Eggs are a symbol of new life reminding us of Jesus' resurrection on Easter Sunday.

Can you decorate your egg? You could do patterns or you could do a miniature version of the Easter story on your egg.




Outdoor Activity Suggestions

Egg and spoon race

Hard boil some eggs and write your names on them (or use the ones you have already decorated). Decide on a course and see who can get round the fastest carrying their egg on a spoon.

Egg rolling

Use the eggs from the race and find a grassy bank in your garden or the park and roll your eggs down the hill. See whose egg goes furthest, whose egg is fastest.



Use some bricks or recycle some packages to make a model of the tomb. Can you make the stone roll away to show the empty tomb?



A Cooking

Edible Easter Scene

You will need:

- A mini chocolate ring donut
- A small round chocolate biscuit (e.g. an Oreo)
- Green icing
- A plain flat biscuit (e.g. a digestive)
 Optional coloured icing and cake decoration flowers
 - Spoon or spatula
 - Knife

Spread the green icing over the top of your flat biscuit using the back of your spoon or a spatula. Cut a slice off the ring donut and stick the flat edge into the green icing. This represents the tomb. Use the small round biscuit to represent the stone rolled away from the tomb. You can decorate your Easter garden with coloured icing or cake decoration flowers.
