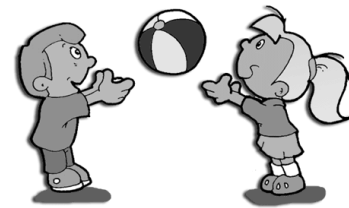

Dear Parent/guardian,


