Craft Activity

Hidden objects

You will need:

• A bag or pillow case

• Some objects from round the house

Find some unusual shaped objects from around the house, e.g. a brush, a piece of fruit, a paper clip. Make a list of the ones you have chosen. Place them inside the bag/pillow case.

Ask a friend or someone in your family to close their eyes and put their hand into the bag. Can they work out the objects in the bag by just touching them – no peaking!

Swap over and let the other person choose what goes in the bag for you to guess.



Secret Messages (you will need help from a grown up for this)

You will need:

- White paper
- Lemon
- Small glass
- Knife

- Cotton buds/cocktail stick with some cotton wool wrapped round
- An iron

Cut the lemon in half (ask a grown up for help) and squeeze the juice into the glass. Dip the cotton bud into the lemon juice and write your secret message on the paper. Let it dry so that the writing becomes invisible. To reveal your secret message gently iron the paper with a warm iron (ask a grown up for help).

Outdoor Activity Suggestions

Blindfolded obstacle course

You'll need someone in your family you can trust for this activity! Together design a course round the garden or park, you could put some obstacles in the way. Then take it turns, one person puts on a blindfold and the other guides them round the course avoiding the obstacles. Then swap over.
