The service gives us the opportunity to celebrate God's love and mission worldwide and includes the dedication of the Easter Offering (envelopes will be made available in your Chapels in the weeks leading up to Easter), all of which goes to the World Mission Fund of the Methodist Church in Britain, supporting and working with over 100 Partner Churches and organisations around the world. I recognise that for some of us travelling across our Circuit presents challenges so there are 2 morning Circuit Services on **Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> April**, one at Leyburn led by me, and one at Richmond led by Rev Julia. We would love to see you at either.

And finally, the 3<sup>rd</sup> Circuit Service on **Sunday May 14<sup>th</sup> at 10.30am**, is a very special one indeed. A time to gather with all your friends from across the Circuit and the local Anglican Deanery at the wonderful venue of Tennants in Leyburn (with grateful thanks to Rodney Tennant). I am delighted to say that Rev Richard Andrew, our Chair of District will be preaching, and the Leyburn Band will be providing the music. My colleague Rev Stephen Hanscombe, Vicar of Leyburn and Bellerby and Assistant Area Dean, will be coordinating this celebration in honour of the King's Coronation. I am only sorry that I will not be there, but my sabbatical will have started by then, however Rev Julia will be present and I look forward to hearing all about it.

I have been using these letters to bring you up to date with the progress of selling Circuit property and I am delighted to say that the Aysgarth Chapel sale finally completed on 19<sup>th</sup> December. It is also planned to go to Auction on 28<sup>th</sup> March to sell Ravensworth Chapel, and at the time of writing the Circuit has accepted an offer on the old Leyburn manse in St Matthews Terrace.
